Commissioners reviewed Authority financial statements as of July 31, 2015. Mr. Bart discussed the significant revenue and expense variances (budget to actual) for the first half of the year. ATTORNEY/EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Mr. Bier discussed the revenue and expense variances for the six months ending July 31, 2015.

Mr. Bier reported on landscaping and grounds clearing in River Place Lot, B-Lot and the Railroad embankment along B-Lot.

Line restriping in the deck is completed, using the new line striping machine.

A sump pump water discharge pipe inside the concrete wall, in the lower level of the garage broke, and needs to be repaired. The repair will be made by not breaking the wall and replacing the pipe. Instead a discharge pipe will be installed and strapped to the exterior of the wall and sump pump water will be discharged into the deck drain system. The pipe will have clean out and freeze plugs. This alternate method of repair will save the Authority \$4,000+ and will not require the excavation and patching of the poured in place concrete wall.

Mr. Bier reported that there has been some settling of sidewalk on Lewis Street, where the sidewalk meets the exterior wall of the deck, which is affecting the caulking along the length of the exterior wall. Mr. Bier is looking into the best fix for this situation.

Commissioner Kabel asked who is responsible for the sidewalk across the street. Mr. Bier advised that it is the Parking Authority's responsibility for sidewalks and curbs.
